

Jamie's leadership style is empathic - where every employee is valued and treated like family, and where patients are treated like family as well.

Jamie leads a company that has grown to over 1,600 employees, 200 ambulances, three medical helicopters, and two fixed wing aircraft - and that responds to over 220,000 calls a year. Yet Pafford Medical Services still maintains a family-centered atmosphere. Jamie is also a non-stop advocate for EMS and the ambulance industry at the local, state and national level. She is chair of the American Ambulance Association's Government Affairs Committee and she is affectionately known on Washington DC's Capitol Hill as "The Ambulance Lady from Arkansas."
